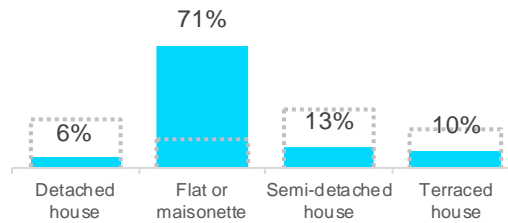




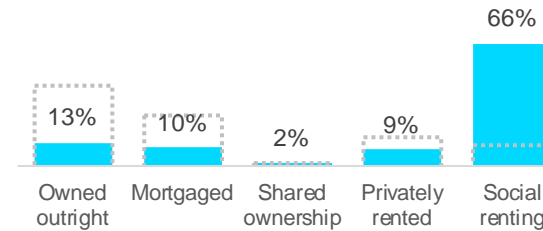

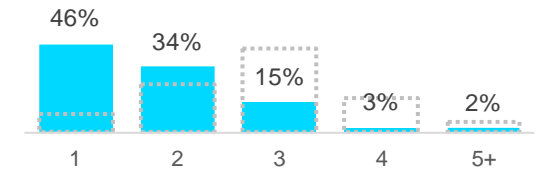
House type

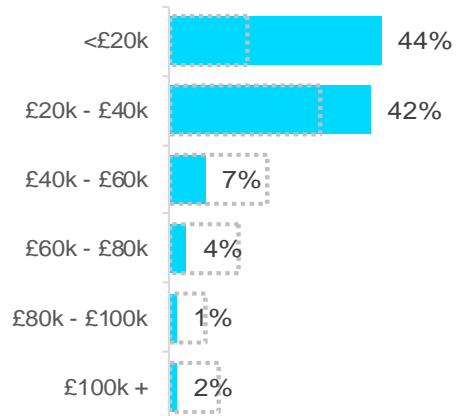

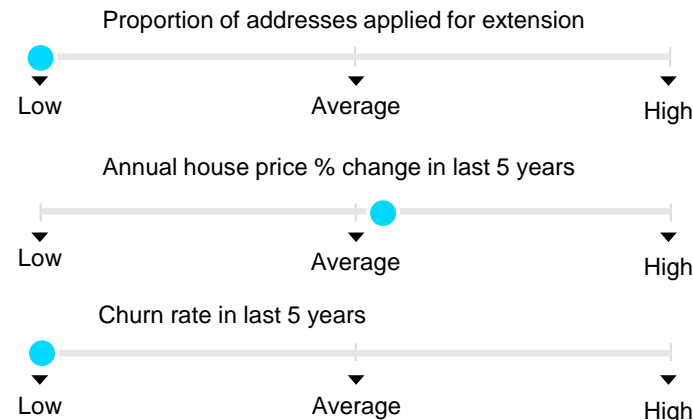

Household income gross before tax

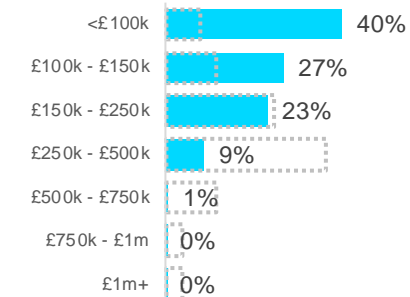
